SUMMARY of Our Main BELIEFS

We are required to know and to believe ALL of these beliefs. There is no room for Cafeteria Catholics here because there is NO such thing as a protestant Catholic, and remember that we only have to break ONE Commandment to end up in hell. After all, we either win or we lose, we either end up in Heaven or in hell. Not that God Almighty wills us to go to hell, but only because we CHOOSE to go there. We must NOT conform our Faith to the world; on the contrary, we are called to conform the world to our Faith. So let us live as we would like to die since we shall die as we have lived.

- ✓ We believe in One Supreme, Eternal, Infinite God, the Creator of Heaven and earth.
- The good ones will be rewarded by Him for ever in Heaven, and the wicked, who die unrepentant, will be punished for ever in Hell.
- ✓ We believe that in the Holy Trinity there are three Persons, Coeternal, and Coequal: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.
- ✓ The Second Person of the Holy Trinity became man and died on the Cross to save us.
- ✓ We belief all the doctrines of the Apostles' Creed.
- ✓ We abide by all the Commandments of God.
- ✓ We abide by all the Precepts of the Catholic Church.
- We believe that the Seven Sacraments were instituted by Christ to give us grace; especially, that Baptism is necessary and that the Eucharist is a pledge of our future glory.
- We believe that Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scripture, which together form one sacred deposit of the Word of God, are entrusted to the Church.
- ✓ We believe in whatever God teaches us by His Church, who in her teaching cannot deceive us or be deceived.

ACT OF FAITH: O my God, I firmly believe that you are one God in three divine Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit; I believe that your divine Son became man and died for our sins, and that he shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe these and all the truths that the holy Catholic Church teaches, because you have revealed them, who can neither deceive nor be deceived.

ACT OF HOPE: O my God, relying on your almighty power and infinite mercy and promises, I hope to obtain pardon for my sins, the help of your grace, and life everlasting, through the merits of Jesus Christ, my Lord and Redeemer.

ACT OF CHARITY: O my God, I love you above all things, with my whole heart and soul, because you are all-good and worthy of all love. I love my neighbor as myself for the love of you. I forgive all who have injured me and ask pardon of all whom I have injured.
